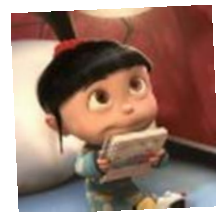


DESPICABLE ME

GREAT AMERICAN CLEAN-UP

The Town of Lake Clarke Shores, together with Keep Palm Beach County Beautiful, will be holding a Waterway Clean-Up on Saturday, April 16. Donations of boats, time and/or tools are needed. *Registration will be held at the Lake Clarke Shores boat ramp at 8:00am.*

In 2010 we hosted this event and overloaded two 20 yard dumpsters with various items of “interesting” debris totaling over 5 tons. It is indeed disheartening to see what fellow humans dispose of into our precious waterways.

All residents interested in keeping Lake Clarke Shores beautiful and protecting our precious environment, are invited to participate.

Volunteers on boats and pontoons in the lake and pedestrians on the shorelines are needed. We will be providing a luncheon cookout at the Town Hall pavilion for all the workers following the cleanup.

We will provide gloves & plastic bags for this effort; however, additional rakes, shovels, gaffs, grabbers, etc. will be appreciated. We highly recommend that all volunteers wear hats and sunscreen. Dumpsters will be at the Town boat ramp for off loading of the debris. Waterfront residents should plan to see us on their shorelines gathering debris that morning.

COUNCIL NEWS

At the February 8th Town Council Meeting

The Following Action Was Taken:

Approved January 11, 2011 Public Hearing Minutes regarding the Capital Improvement Element of the Comprehensive Plan.

Approved January 11, 2011 Town Council Meeting Minutes.

Approved Interlocal Agreement between the City of Lake Worth and the Town of Lake Clarke Shores for the purchase and sale of bulk potable water to Hypoluxo Village.

Approved Resolution #11-04 authorizing the Town to execute the agreement between the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections and the Town of Lake Clarke Shores for vote processing equipment use and election services for the Town's 2011 municipal election.

Approved Resolution #11-05 designating the Supervisor of Elections and one (1) Palm Beach County Commissioner as the Lake Clare Shores Canvassing Board, to be in attendance for the testing of the electronic tabulating equipment, to canvas returns of elections and run-off elections and assigning the Supervisor of Elections to handle absentee ballots.

Approved to declare the following Police Vehicle as surplus and to allow for advertisement of sale by sealed bid – 2000 Ford Explorer Vin#1FMDU62X5YZA81101

Approved the use unappropriated funds (or fund balance), if needed, in the amount of \$5,385.00 to purchase video equipment and a radar unit for use in the new Police vehicle (Unit #111). The purchase is necessary to replace the incompatible analog video equipment and obsolete radar unit from the old police vehicle (2000 Ford Explorer). Labor is included in the price.

Approved Forfeiture Expenditure in the amount of \$1256.00 for the Police Department purchase of one computer, all programs and installation, to be placed in the Town Council Chambers which is used as the backup Emergency Operations Center and is utilized for ongoing police training as well as public education for the Town neighborhood crime watch prevention program.

Approved Land Use Permit – Gholam Rahman, 7519 West Lake Drive – Seawall

Approved Second and Final Reading of Ordinance #11-01 – Amending the Town's Comprehensive Plan to implement updates to the Capital Improvement Element; including changes to the 5-year schedule of improvements; Demonstrating financial feasibility as required by state statute; Providing direction for transmittal of the proposed comprehensive plan amendment to the Department of Community Affairs; Providing for conflicts, severability and an effective date.

Approved First reading of Ordinance #11-02 – Amending the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 86 "Zoning" Concerning "Pain Management Clinics"; Extending the Temporary Moratorium upon acceptance of applications for or issuance of zoning approvals or other development orders for "Pain Management Clinics" for an additional six (6) months period; Providing for inclusion in the Code of Ordinances; Providing for severability; Providing for an effective date and for other purposes.

NPDES

Remember – Lawn and landscape debris should not be put on top of a storm drain when placed at curbside for pick up. Do not blow or sweep loose vegetation into storm drains either, as the storm drains flow directly into the Town's waterways. Do not discard any type of vegetation into the canals and lakes as the debris could block the normal flow of water. Keeping lakes and canals clean and flowing freely is everyone's responsibility. Call the LCS Police Department to report violations by contacting the non-emergency dispatch center at 964-1114.



Right Tree, Right Place

Trees come in all shapes and sizes, and often change dramatically over their lifetimes. Some grow tall, some grow wide and some have extensive root systems. Before selecting your tree, do some research. Make sure you know how tall, wide and deep it will be at maturity. Where you plant your tree is just as important as what type of tree you plant. Blocking an unsightly view or creating some shade may be a priority, but you must also think about how your tree will impact existing overhead and underground utility lines, sidewalks, or driveways as it grows taller, wider and deeper. If you aren't sure what's underground, call the free underground utility line locator service by dialing 8-1-1. Taking the time to consider location now can prevent avoidable expenses for years to come.
